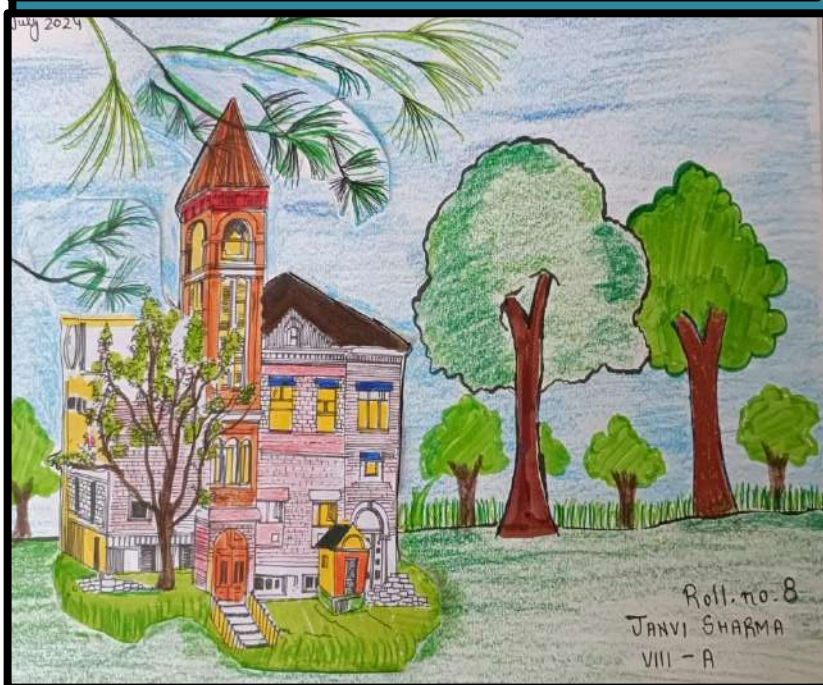

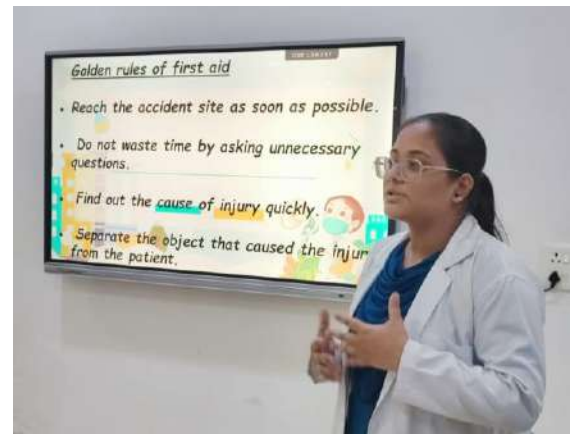

WORKSHOPS AND SEMINARS

WORKSHOP ON FIRST AID

JUNE 28,2024

The students were happy to be recognized by the Principal.



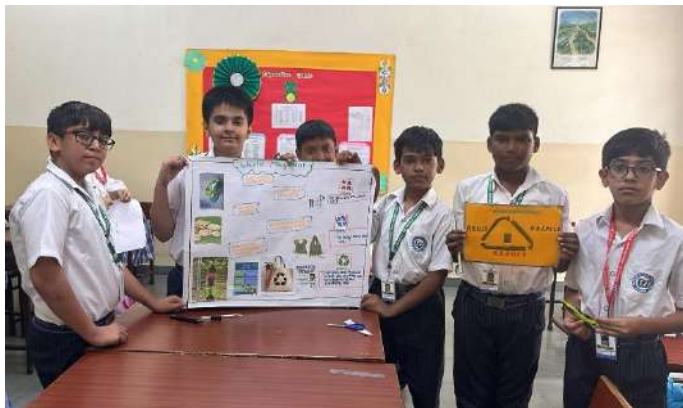
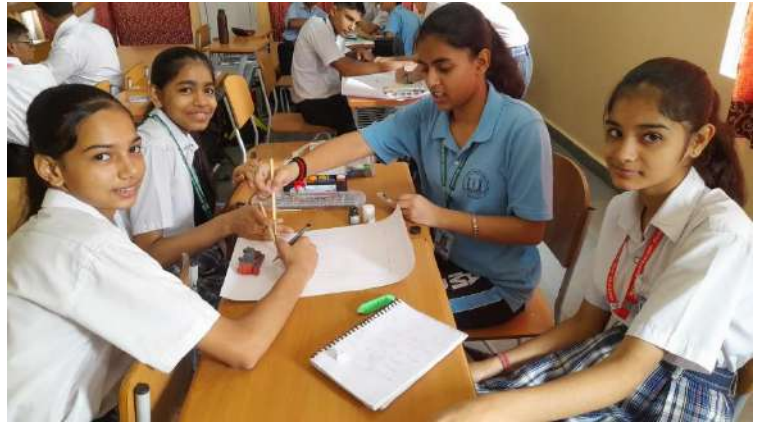
FANCY DRESS COMPETITION
