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## MONTESSORI ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

A special programme for the new Academic Session was conducted in early April in the Junior Wing. Our Founder Chairperson Ms. Lalita Trehan addressed the parents and told them about the Montessori methodology designed to support the



natural development of the young child in a well-prepared environment. She discussed the key aspects of Montessori pedagogy such as respect for the child, observing the child, a structured and prepared learning environment, the use of practical and sensorial learning materials, and freedom of choice. She highlighted the benefits of Montessori education such as “*self-education*” (that the children are capable of educating themselves), peer learning, enjoyment of freedom within limits, development of concentration and independence. There was a questionnaire session at the end. The workshop was well attended and AMPS Parents actively interacted with Ms. Trehan, sharing parenting challenges and receiving practical tips and solutions to their queries.

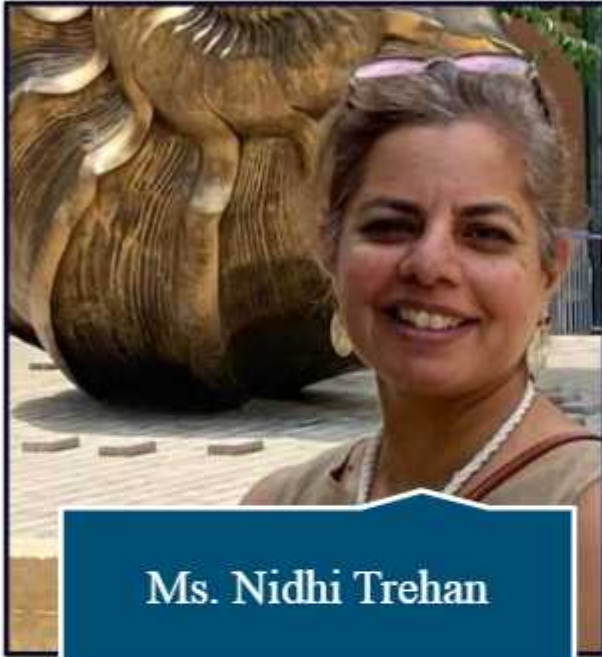
