 - 2. Aadhar card of father and mother
- 5. Baptism certificate of the child in case of Christians only
- 6. Caste Certificate (in the Child's name) optional
- 7. Medical Certificate compulsory in case of disability

Child for whom admission is desired has to be born st between 1 May 2012 to 31 May 2013.


