















Republic Day Celebration



The students dispersed for home at 10 am spending a half day at school but with hearts full of desires and zeal to return to school the next day morning.












AN ADIEU

In the end, the Principal addressed the students by helping them realize the true value of the two days. The Principal thanked the teachers and the students for their efforts.









Educational tour (Classes I - IV)

The Programme ended with a DJ music and children enjoyed it by dancing. Sweets were distributed to our children during the last period.










A Real Experience to a Village - Saguna Baug

The message of Christmas of Christ's birth as the saviour of the world was clear.












Christmas Celebration with Unfortunate
