
The competition started at 10:30 AM. All the participants of each house were sitting on their respective places and other students as audience. Teacher Suja introduced all the participants and




Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel

The theme for the day was 'To our dear students, with love, Teachers'.












Picnic tour
