The Programme concluded with sumptuous lunch. Students of X enjoyed the celebration. We bid farewell to them and wish them good luck.










Staff Picnic

June 21, 2018 Categories: News





The workshop concluded with a game followed by lunch which was organised by the Fortis Group. A good moment to cherish as each participant along with the teacher received certificate of Participation.








Fort Drawing Competition (CLASS: IV)

Also the winners of this competition will be awarded with a certificate.












HANDWRITING COMPETITION




A handwriting competition was organised by the literary club for all the students from STD I to X on 27th July, 2018.

The aim of the competition was to inculcate competitive spirit and to develop reading, writing and listening skills in English language.








SPORTS CLUB: CHESS AND TABLE TENNIS COMPETITION








ANNUAL SPORTS MEET 2018-19 (SECONDARY SECTION)
