- Sailing the ship with the help of variety of satellites and radar networks and apparatus
- Scanning weather and sailing information
- Synchronizing the secure lading, depot and dispatching of freight
- Surveying the ship to ensure that the health and security measures are in place
- Checking and regulating security, firefighting and life-saving apparatus
- Watching and sustaining all the electrical apparatus on board to ensure the security and efficacy of the ship.
- Dealing with the job of marking and giving training and assisting trainee officers
- Staying abreast of advancements in nautical methods, commercial and governmental matters
