In this context, each student is given a sum of Rs 50/- and is asked to spend the amount for a charitable purpose. They are also asked to share their experience of utilizing the amount that they have spent. This provides them a chance to make the right decision based on their judgment and conscience. A plethora of activities viz; thinking activity, storytelling, dramatization, assembly talks by teachers and students are regularly organized to interweave the concept of Sanskar Samvardhan. It has become an indispensable part of the teaching learning process. It also motivates them to practice philanthropy in their lives and contribute for worthwhile purposes.

## EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT

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*"True knowledge is not gained by mere study; it comes from within, through deep meditation and contemplation."* Board results of classes X and XII were declared by CBSE on 12 May 2023. Students gave an excellent performance and achieved 99.5% and 98.9% pass percentages in classes X and XII respectively. Atishay Jain, Khiyati Sharma and Anushka Gupta were the toppers in class X with 94.8%, 94.4%, and 93.8.% marks respectively. In class XII, Archita (Humanities stream) was the school topper by securing 96.8% marks. Aryan Sharma & Prachi Saini topped the Science stream by securing 95.4%. marks each. Kanishka Garg made her school proud by securing 95.2% marks and topped the commerce stream.
