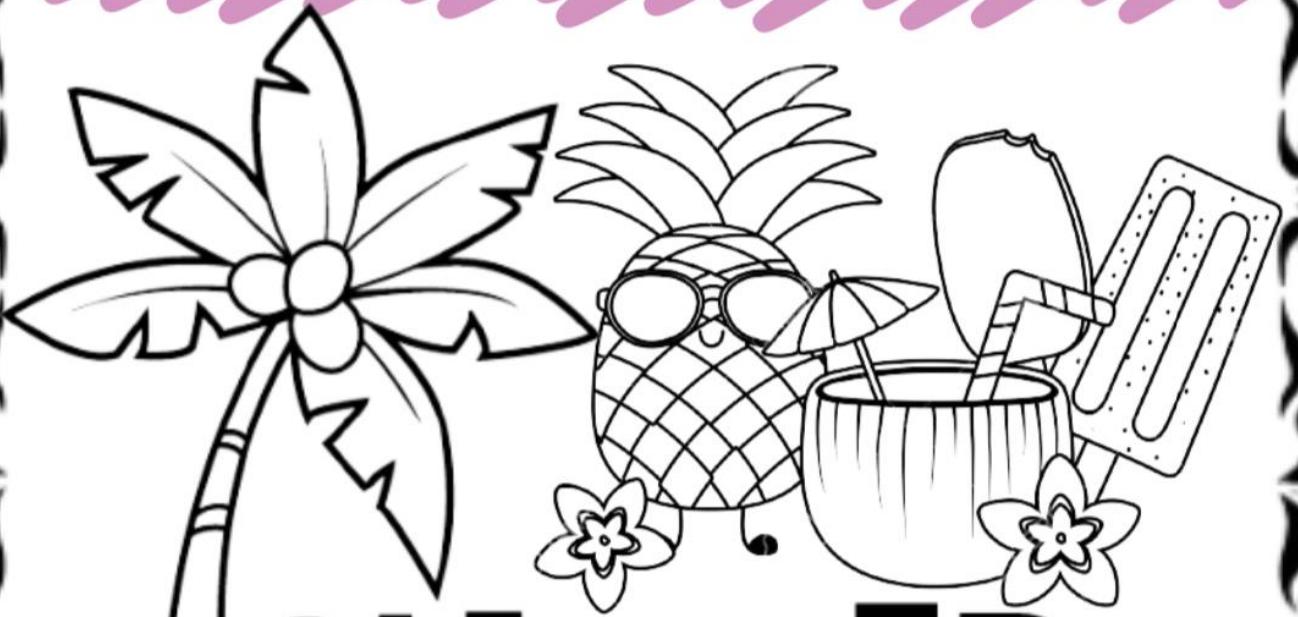

2. Epic Journey: Dive into our cultural heritage by reading "बाल काण्ड" from our ancient epic- "रामायण"

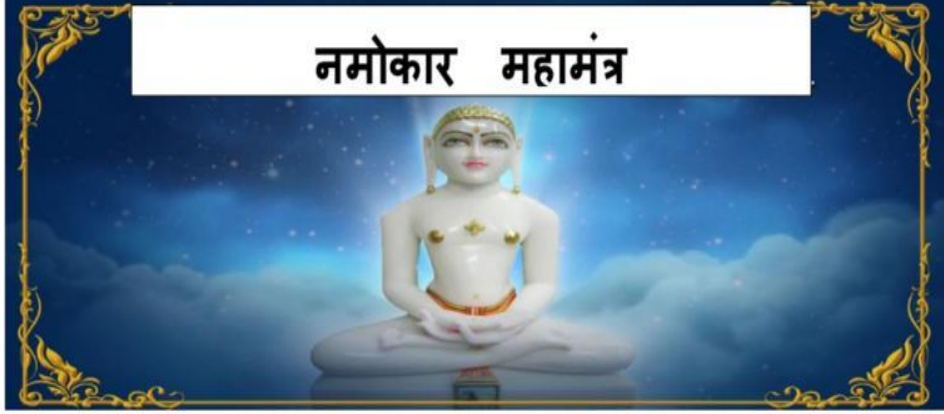
An MCQ test will be conducted after the vacation.

- Instructions:

Choose a Container: Find a sturdy box or container that can be sealed.

Select Items: Choose 5-10 items that represent your life, interests, and the society around you. These could be photographs, newspaper clippings, drawings, letters, or small objects.

Document Details: Write a brief description for each item explaining its significance.

Seal the Capsule: Place all items in the container and seal it securely.

Label and Store: Label the container with your name, date, and a message for future generations. Store it in a safe place.

Reflection Questions:

- What do the items you selected reveal about your life and the society you live in?
- How do you think society might change by the time the capsule is opened in the future?
- What message would you like to convey to future generations through this time capsule?

- Make a record of all these questions.
