






World Class Campus

The Lotus Valley International School campus is strategically designed to provide an ideal and secure environment for its students.

- The campus has large open spaces as well as appropriately planned buildings for Pre Primary, Middle & Senior Wings, providing ample space for outdoor as well as indoor activities.
- Expansive green belts intersperse urban development and help maintain the ecological balance. All this ensures a pollution free environment in which your child can breathe easy.
- Central monitoring systems make the three buildings totally safe, ensuring complete security for all the students.
- Vehicular traffic within the campus is controlled to ensure complete safety of the children.
- The forms and colours of the buildings have been carefully designed to provide mental stimulation for children.
- Interior spaces throughout the school are child-friendly with no sharp edges or rough surfaces.
- Silent generators are installed to ensure a constant, effective power supply.

Curriculum & Pedagogy

The Curriculum is characterized by with a unique integration of the best of educational practices from India and abroad. The school follows the curriculum designed by the NCERT & our learners are prepared for the AISSCE (All India Senior Secondary Certificate Examination) conducted by the CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education) for Classes X & XII.

The pedagogical initiatives at Lotus Valley promote active and self-directed learning. Experiential learning activities, such as storytelling, flip teaching, hands-on experiments, and role plays help students construct knowledge through their own actions. Integrated learning activities, including interdisciplinary, multidisciplinary, and trans-disciplinary projects & events, facilitate connections between academics and real-life experiences. The school also emphasizes the use of digital tools and technology, enabling students to become creators and use technology for societal advancement.

Pre Primary

A child- centric integrated approach to kindergarten curriculum recognizes different aspects of the child's development. Activities and play are valued as an essential medium for learning, thus making learning joyful and exciting.

Primary

The focus is on the holistic development of the child keeping the three H's in mind - Heart, Head and Hand. Experiential learning through exploratory and activity based teaching keeps the young learners engaged and makes learning easy and effective.

Early Primary

At this level a rigorous, academically challenging CBSE curriculum is followed to prepare students for higher education and life beyond school.






Centre for Learning Enhancement

Inclusive School

We are an Inclusive School and support teachers to include students with diverse needs in the classroom through good inclusive practices—like collaboration, team work, innovative instructional practices, peer-strategies, and more. Individual Education Plans are developed for students with special needs where a Psychologist, Special Educators, Operational Therapist, Speech Therapist, Language Therapist, along with class teachers, subject teachers, and parents work together to ensure that each child is well adjusted and happy, with the aim of maximizing his / her potential. The students attend remedial, occupational therapy and speech therapy sessions as per their need to bridge learnings gap. At the CLE, there are different equipment used to cater to their needs, i.e., sand play to provide tactile stimulation, trampoline to provide proprioceptive input, horse riding for vestibular stimulation , oral-motor exercises to deal with speech and language issues, multisensory programme to enhance reading and spellings, etc.













Mental Health and Well Being

At Lotus valley, we strongly believe in the holistic development of each child. With the aim of seeing happy faces across all 12 acres of our premises, our trained counselling psychologists help the children in their emotional, behavioural, motivational and psycho-social needs. Emphasis is given to the counselling of students to ensure their emotional development. The focus on Counselling is not only limited to individual issues but also on broader areas like bullying, problem solving, etc, which are taken up during group counselling sessions.

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Career Counselling

Career Counselling is an integral part of our curriculum. Experts are invited to conduct career awareness talks. The counsellors conduct aptitude tests, interest checks and holds interactive sessions with students and parents. This helps the learners understand their forte and make an informed choice for a career.






The International Dimension

Amenities

LVIS offers a myriad of state-of-the-art amenities and facilities which help in providing our students an ideal, secure, and healthy learning environment.

Medical Facility

The school has a tie-up with a leading hospital, which monitors the health of our students. The centers are adequately staffed with a two full time doctors assisted by three qualified, experienced nurses who take care of the general physical development of our children and provide immediate first-aid treatment, as required. Medical check-up for height, weight, eye-sight and dental health are conducted on a regular basis. This helps in identifying any problem at the initial stage. An ambulance is on standby in case of any medical emergencies.





Cafeteria

Our innovatively decorated cafeterias serve healthy and nutritious snacks in hygienic and healthy surroundings. Lunch is served, keeping in mind the dietary requirements of the growing child. The menu of the meal served to the students is not only high in nutritional value but also caters to the tastes of our children. There are two cafeterias – one for the primary section that can seat around 100 students and the other for the senior section catering to over 500 students.

Media Centers

The media centers are interactive resource rooms that are more than just libraries. Not only do they house a wide collection of books for all ages, the e-section has a collection of DVDs, videos and on-line learning material. The libraries also have designated areas for individual study and small-group tutorials, with modern conference facilities for larger numbers.

A fleet of over 90 air-conditioned buses, duly fitted with CCTV cameras and GPS tracking system, ensure a smooth, comfortable, and safe commute for students. Each bus is monitored by a teacher, security guard, and bus monitors, who collectively ensure discipline in the bus.



Presently, she is a sportscaster, commentator and subject expert with several leading news and sports channels.

Sagarika Ghose (born 8th November 1964) is an Indian journalist, news anchor and author. She has been a journalist since 1991 and has worked with Outlook magazine, The Times of India and The Indian Express. She was the Deputy Chief Editor and also the Prime Editor of CNNIBN.
