Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, recognition to your school is granted from classes I to VIII (without aid) w.e.f. 1983-84 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act & Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. ✓ That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible staff for all the classes of the school as per the present norms of the department.
4. ✓ That the school shall equip the Science Labs as per the norms of the Department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students.
5. ✓ That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student may be added.
6. ✓ That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Section 10(i) of the Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973.
8. That the enrolment in section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 Sq. ft. per student for the available floor area of the classroom and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of Sections should not exceed the number of existing classrooms of proper size in the school.
9. That the school shall not run any unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the above address only. Nursery class be removed from the premises of the school if any.

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10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and overaged staff, if any, immediately.
11. ✓ That the scheme of management shall be got approved from the Deptt immediately.
12. That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
13. That all the facilities prescribed under Rules 50 & 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
14. ✓ That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the local body within a month.
15. ✓ That the management of the school shall create a reserve fund of Rs. 5,000/- (Rs. Five Thousand) only in a joint account in the name of Director of Education and the Manager of the school in any scheduled bank within a month.
16. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school. That class IX shall not be added to the school without the prior permission of Director of Education, Delhi.
17. ✓ That the management of the school shall procure land from DDA for the school and construct thereon a suitable building for the school within a period of two years and the school is shifted to a new building.
18. That the report about the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilled, shall be sent to Education Officer every six month.

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Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the appropriate authority for upgradation of your school from Secondary to Senior Secondary level (without aid) in Arts and Commerce streams with effect from the session 1993-94 subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act, 1973 and Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall meet the additional liability of Senior Secondary classes.
3. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
4. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student shall be purchased and made available to the students.
5. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students.
7. That all the facilities prescribed under Rules 50 and 51 of D.S.E.R.-1973 shall be made available to the students.
8. Proper facilities for drinking water, toilets and first aid be provided. Separate toilets for boys, girls and separate toilets for ladies and gents staff be also provided.
9. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Section 10(1) of the D.S.E.A.-1973.
10. That the school shall not run any un-recognised classes or any non-educational activities within the school premises.
11. Fresh health certificate from M.C.D. be obtained and produced to the Education Officer for verification.
12. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and overaged staff, if any, immediately.

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13. That adequate and sufficient accommodation of 10 sq.ft. per student shall be provided for the class room. The minimum size of the class room should not be less than 300 sq.ft. (20' x 15') atleast to accommodate 30 students per class/section. The rooms should be properly cross ventilated. The rooms should not be closed from three sides.
14. The Managing Committee of the school shall not increase/enhance fee during the ensuing academic session without the prior approval of the Director of Education which is a mandatory requirement under sub-section (3) of Section 17 of D.S.E.A. 1973.
15. That the Management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund equal to minimum three months salary of the staff in the joint name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the school.
16. That the school shall comply with the norms of the C.B.S.E. for affiliation fee/examination purposes.
17. That report about the fulfilment of the above conditions shall be sent to the Education Officer within six months.
