Fill the form and submit it in the school office latest **by 20 January 2025**. (Office will be open Monday- Friday 9.00 a.m. – 1.00 p.m.) You may also please note that **filling up of the form is not a guarantee that the stream which is sought will be allotted to your daughter**. Kindly give your 2nd/3rd preference in the form as allocation will be based on merit, requisite of the stream and availability of seats. Therefore, it is in the interest of your child that you give a great deal of thought before deciding on the stream. However, the Principal reserves the right to change any stream in the best interest and aptitude of the student without assigning any further reason whatsoever. **If you do not wish to continue your daughter's further studies in this school, kindly inform in writing through this form.**

CRITERIA

Provisional admission will be based on the overall academic performance. **Cut off for stream will be depending on the board result**. The Principal reserves the right to change the criteria in the interest of the school and the students.

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- *Students who have chosen Basic Mathematics in Class X may not be eligible to study Mathematics in Class XI, although this eligibility could change based on CBSE guidelines. However, they can apply for Applied Mathematics instead.*
- *The introduction of Applied Mathematics will be contingent upon a minimum of 25 student enrolments.*
- *Students who choose additional subjects may not be able to attend regular classes.*
- *Yoga as an additional skill subject is offered for all the streams*

Academic Requirements

- **Students will be deemed fit for CBSE examination at the end of Class XII** only if they have completed **two years in the same stream and have a minimum of 80% Attendance** in school.
- The Board will conduct examination in all subjects except General Studies, Work Experience and Physical & Health Education, which will be assessed internally by the school.
- Students are reminded that regular attendance and regularity of work in both Scholastic and non-scholastic subjects are essential requirements in Classes XI and XII.
- For Class XI and XII students, the school will follow a Monday to Friday schedule. Regular attendance is mandatory in Class XI, along with consistent academic progress and disciplined behavior, in order to be promoted to Class XII.
- Every student of Class XI must sit for every Test and Examination in each subject and secure a minimum of 40% marks in order to gain promotion to Class XII. Absence will not be considered as being sufficient reason nor will re-tests be held. Regular inability/unwillingness to sit for the tests is a clear indication that the student is not fit to take the 'Plus Two' Course of studies as a regular student.
- The Principal is free to refuse continuation of studies to any student whose discipline/conduct is found to be unsatisfactory at any time even after the 'Plus Two' Course has been undertaken.
- Adherence to Rules in the school diary is very essential for continuation of studies at the 'Plus Two' level.

In all matters relating to the above, the Principal's decision will be final and binding.

ANNEXURE-I

SCHEME OF STUDIES SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL EXAMINATION (CLASS XII) 2024-2025		
Class XI and XII is an integrated course. Students will study only those subjects in Class XII which he/she has studied in Class XI. Students can offer a minimum of 5 subjects as under:-

Important Instructions: -	
(i)	Hindi or English must be one of the two languages to be studied in classes XI and XII. Hindi and English can also be offered simultaneously. In Hindi and in English, two courses are being offered for classes XI and XII. Keeping in view the varying backgrounds of the students and a student may either opt for Hindi Elective (Code 002) or Hindi Core (Code 302) and English Elective (Code-01) or English Core (Code -301). However, the same language cannot be offered both at Core and Elective levels.
(ii)	The first 5 subjects in the chronological order of filling the subjects in the online registration system/ Mark Sheet are considered as Main subjects.
(iii)	If a student has taken 6 subjects, and if he/she fails in any one of first five subjects, the same will be replaced by the 6th subject provided the candidate satisfies the scheme of studies viz. after replacement by the 6th subject, either Hindi or English remains as one of the main five subjects.
(iv)	For candidates who take 6 subjects (5 main and 1 additional subject) and pass in all 6 subjects, the percentage is to be calculated, as per their requirement/rule, by the employer/institution/university according to the norms of the Institution/University/Employer in which the candidate will be seeking admission/employment. CBSE does not calculate and provide the percentage.
(v)	Only those subjects can be offered by the school to the students for which approval of CBSE has been obtained.
(vi)	The board has prescribed a scheme of studies which is available in the Curriculum on the link http://cbseacademic.nic.in for Secondary and Senior Secondary classes. Schools are required to offer the subjects (subject to permission by the Board) in adherence with the Scheme of Studies only.
(vii)	CBSE does not have a concept of streams. Students can take 5/6 subjects as per the above scheme out of those listed in the curriculum and available in the school concerned. Schools admit students as per the criteria laid down by its management.
