- (vii) **Discussion:** Discuss briefly the implication of your results and suggest extensions of any kind that can be undertaken.
- (viii) **Conclusion**: In view of the results obtained and related work done on the topic of the project, write conclusion briefly.
- (ix) **References:** Any work related to the project which you have come across through books/articles or any other source should be written as reference, for example: Michael Michalco (2001), Cracking Creativity, Berkeley, Ten Speed Press. This write up is meant to train the students in scientific methods. In other words, it accentuates the spirit of enquiry and investigation in young minds.
